(Local Time) on February 24, 2010, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after this time will be returned unopened. Each Bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the title "Storm Water Drainage Improvements for the Town of Lyons" and the name and address of Bidder.

The OWNER reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any and all bids. Award will be made to the low, responsive, responsible bidder. No proposal may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for at least sixty (60) days. A conditional or qualified bid will not be accepted.

Each BIDDERS must deposit with his bid, a certified check or acceptable bidder's bond made payable to the owner, in a sum not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid. This check or bond will be held by the owner as evidence that the bidder will, if awarded the contract, enter into the same with the owner upon notification from him to do so within ten (10) days of said notification.

Contractor receiving award shall furnish an approved Performance Bond, Labor and Material Payment Bond in an amount at least equal to 100% of the contract amount and must be in full force and effect throughout the term of the construction project plus a period of twelve (12) months from the date of substantial completion. Bonds shall be furnished at time of notice to proceed of contract.

Each BIDDERS must complete and submit with BID Indiana Form 96 inclusive of Non-Collusion Affidavit (furnished by Bidder) Standard Questionnaire and Financial Statement and other required documents as required by Indiana law.

Contractors and subcontractors are required to pay not less than prevailing wage rates established by the U.S. Dept. of Labor and included in the project specifications. Information explaining other prevailing wage laws which apply to this work is also contained in the project specifications.

Bidders on this work shall be required to comply with the provisions of the President's Executive Order No. 11246, as amended. The Bidders shall also comply with the requirements of 41 CFR Part 60 - 4 entitled Construction Contractors - Affirmative Action Requirements. A copy of 41 CFR Part 60 - 4 may be found in the Supplemental General Conditions of the Contract Documents and Specifications.

The Bidders' attention is also called to the "Minority/Women Business Participation" requirements contained in the Project Specifications. The State of Indiana, Office of Community and Rural Affairs, has adopted a State goal of 10% participation for minority and female owned businesses for construction related or purchase related contracts for the work.

In addition, the Contractor must meet guidelines and practices established by the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs and appropriate Federal regulations including:

- 11) Contractors and Subcontractors Certifications, and others that may be appropriate or necessary.

In addition, the Contract Division procurement is subject to the Federal Regulations contained in the OMB Circular A-102, Sections B and O and the State of Indiana requirements contained in IC-36-1-9 and IC-36-1-12.

Any contract(s) awarded under this Advertisement for Bids are expected to be funded in part by a grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development, as administered by the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs through its Disaster Recovery 2 Grant Program. Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies or employees is or will be a party to this Advertisement or Bids or any resulting contract.
